CARE PLAN

- Records which pre-date the illness/accident are summarized separately and briefly under "Pre-dated Records."
- A Source List of the Facilities and Physicians who rendered medical services with their respective city and state is provided at the beginning of the summarized report.
- Billing sheets and other documents like plaintiff's petition, patient's employment records, expert opinions, driver license, etc. are listed.

REVIEW

- Each clinical encounter is reviewed starting with date of service, provider name and type of service, followed by the encouter summary.
- At the end of each encounter, page tagging references the source file and page number.
- Flow of events is maintained by reviewing inpatient services records in the following order:

- 1. EMS/Ambulance Report
- 2. Emergency Department Report
- 3. History and Physical Report
- 4. Consultations
- 5. Radiology
- 6. Operative Report
- 7. Therapy Evaluations
- 8. Discharge Summary
- Laboratory reports, inpatient progress notes and anesthesia records are not summarized.
- Only the initial and final Physical/Occupational/ Acupuncture/Chiropractic Therapy evaluations are summarized.
- For radiological studies like X-rays, CT, MRI, etc., all the findings (normal and abnormal) are reviewed at the first occurrence in the case. In the subsequent studies, only the abnormal findings are reviewed.
- For outpatient followup visits with the same provider, only complaints/progress of patient's condition and physician's recommendations/ opinions are summarized.
